CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR BSE POLICY FELLOWSHIPS



The INSIGHTS project at the Berlin School of Economics (BSE) aims to support the communication and transfer of research results to the public. INSIGHTS is funded by the Leibniz Gemeinschaft and has two main pillars: a platform of exchange between researchers, policymakers, the media, and the public, and the provision of professional guidance and formal training on science communication for junior researchers of BSE partner institutions: BCCP, DIW, ESMT Berlin, FU Berlin, Hertie School, HU Berlin, Universität Potsdam, TU Berlin and WZB Berlin.

We offer six **fellowships to policymakers and practitioners to do a research visit of up to 12 weeks** at one of the cooperating institutions between 2022 and 2024 – to focus on a research question of their own while profiting from the dialogue with researchers in their field in the Berlin area. The fellowship grants a monthly lump sum stipend of $3.500 \in$ per person.

The fellowship gives the opportunity to collaborate closely with researchers, to gain access to state-of-the-art methods and the most recent research.

BSE Policy Fellows are encouraged to participate in all academic activities of the BSE, like talks and seminars.

We invite civil servants from public institutions as well as members of policy-oriented NGOs and the private sector with a strong academic background and an interest in research.

Please choose the BSE partner institution you want to visit (**see above**) that fits best to your research project. We also ask you to start a cooperation with a junior or senior member of the BSE partner institutions even at the application stage, before submitting your proposal, to show this fit.

With your application, please submit the following documents to **insightsoffice@wzb.eu**

- your research proposal including the research question and a work schedule (max. 3 pages)
- a letter of endorsement of a senior policy maker or practitioner
- name of cooperation partner and institution
- your CV

We accept applications on a rolling basis.
