

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR POLICY CONFERENCE PRESENTATIONS BY BSE JUNIOR MEMBERS



The INSIGHTS project at the Berlin School of Economics (BSE) aims to support the communication and transfer of research results to the public. INSIGHTS is funded by the Leibniz Gemeinschaft and has two main pillars: a platform of exchange between researchers, policymakers, the media, and the public, and the provision of professional guidance and formal training on science communication for junior researchers of BSE partner institutions: BCCP, DIW, ESMT Berlin, FU Berlin, Hertie School, HU Berlin, Universität Potsdam, TU Berlin and WZB Berlin.

INSIGHTS supports the presentations of **policy-relevant research** results by BSE junior scholars (doctoral students and research associates) at national and international conferences and topical workshops.

INSIGHTS offers a (partial) reimbursement of travel expenses up to 1,100 € for workshops or larger conferences where you are presenting (please note: No lump sums will be paid!).

Conditions for applying are:

- the presented work and the conference format have a clear **research and policy** component;
- apply at least 2 months in advance, applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis;
- the travel conditions and local hotel caps as laid down in the German Travel Regulation BRKG apply. Please note that it is not possible to combine this business trip with others, nor with private extensions of the stay;
- reimbursement only with original documents within 2 months of the conference;
- after the workshop, you are required to prepare a contribution to one of the INSIGHTS communication outlets (in coordination with the INSIGHTS Team).

- the title of your paper presentation,
- your exact travel plans and expected costs for travel, accommodation
- and registration fee (where applicable)
